Juste un Mouvement is a free take on La Chinoise, the Jean-Luc Godard movie shot in 1967 in Paris. Reallocating its roles and characters 50 years later in Dakar and updating its plot, this new version offers a meditation on the relationship between politics, justice and memory. Although no longer alive, Omar Blondin Diop, the only actual Maoist student in the original movie, now becomes the key character.

Shot exclusively with non-professional actors including Diop's brothers and friends, everyone in this film portrays themselves: a filmmaker, a rapper, a poet, a Chinese worker, a Shaolin master, a Senegalese intellectual, the Minister of Culture of Senegal and the Vice President of the People's Republic of China.
